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# COMMUNITY IMMUNITY? WITH THESE VACCINES?

## Influenza? Nope.

Inactivated flu vaccines do not generate protective antibodies in the nasal mucosa, which harbors the flu virus during infection along with the lower respiratory tract. So even if you are protected from the flu symptoms yourself, you can still be colonized by the flu virus in the upper respiratory tract and spread it.



## Whooping Cough? Nope.

The pertussis vaccine *may* suppress symptoms for a short time, but you still colonize and unknowingly carry infection to others. And outbreaks are happening in kids who have had 5 pertussis shots.

## Mumps? Nope.

Recent outbreaks have been in fully vaccinated populations. Merck is heading to trial soon for falsifying data on the mumps portion of MMR.

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
